

SUMMARY OF CAMP NELSON'S USCT CONTRIBUTIONS

Six Kentucky USCT infantry regiments (109th - Louisville; 114th - Camp Nelson; 115th - Bowling Green; 116th - Camp Nelson; 117th - Covington; and 122nd - Louisville) participated in the Siege of Petersburg and Richmond, Virginia. The 109th, 114th, 116th and 117th participated in the Appomattox Court House Campaign and the surrender of General Robert E. Lee and his Army.

The six regiments plus the 107th U. S. Colored Infantry Regiment, organized at Louisville, were assigned to the 25th Army Corps, Army of the James. All were deployed to Texas after the surrender at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, except the 107th which was deployed and participated in the Carolina Campaign. The regiment was active during the surrender of General Joseph E. Johnston and his Army.
